The idea of these trips is to offer a chance for people to visit their local forest, meet other people and gather ideas and thoughts which can be taken to the Knob Reserve and help shape the conversation at that dialogue. What to expect

We will visit some sites around Mirboo North including:

Dickies Hill - to get an overview of the landscape, fire history and bushfire risk

Planned burn - visit a recent planned burn and discuss how they are planned and undertaken

Darimurla - discuss the 2009 fire and bushfire risk in a plantation context

Samson road - Management of the newly created Forest Conservation Park

Bath road - wind damage, debris management and lessons in recovery
