Dickies Hill | an overview of the landscape, fire history and bushfire risk

Railway Rd | a recent planned burn and discuss how they are planned and undertaken

Darlimurla | discuss the 2009 fire and bushfire risk in a plantation context

Samson road | management of the newly created Forest Conservation Park

Baths road | wind damage, debris management and lessons in recovery

About Gippsland Forest Dialogue (GFD)

The Gippsland Forest Dialogue was formed in 2022 and has 60 members. It has held 6 dialogues with over 250 attendees, representing a wide range of experience and perspectives, including local residents, Traditional Owners, recreation groups, volunteers, not-for-profit groups, academics, forest users, government and businesses.

The dialogue uses The Forests Dialogue method, developed by Yale University in 2020, to support respectful, multi-stakeholder conversations about the future of forests.
